



PIRIT™ UTILITY LINE USER INSTRUCTIONS

- Use only with a UL approved GFCI outlet or GFCI extension.
- Before using this hose make sure the washer is placed inside the female coupling.
- Thaw time of your hose will vary depending on outdoor temperature and amount of ice build-up inside of hose.
- Do not leave hose under pressure when not in use.
- Do not leave attachments on hose when not in use.
- When using for radiant heat applications, there is no need for water in the line.
- This hose is NOT designed to provide freeze protection to your water supply, be sure to take appropriate measures to protect your water supply.
- Drain hose when not in use to extend the life of your hose.
- Constructed with FDA approved materials for potable water.
- Do not leave hose coiled or spooled for more than 30 minutes when plugged in.
- Use caution: This is an appliance and should be treated and respected as such.
- Always unplug Utility Line when not in use.

TO PROVIDE CONTINUED PROTECTION AGAINST ELECTRIC SHOCK:

Have a qualified electrician install a properly grounded receptacle outlet, acceptable for outdoor use and protected from snow and rain, immediately adjacent to the location where the heater will be used.

Route the supply cord and locate the heater so as to be protected from damage by live stock.

Do not use extension cords.

Inspect cord before using.

Unplug heater at receptacle outlet when not in use.

Store hose indoors after winter season.
