MAVERICK SOLAR GRILL LAMP

Thank you for purchasing the Maverick Solar Grill Lamp. Cordless and completely solar powered, the lamp's four bright LEDs shed ample light on an outdoor grill after the sun goes down. A stainless-steel clip and adjustable gooseneck allow it to be attached to any grill in seconds.

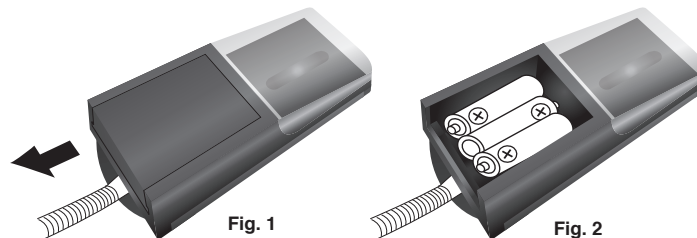
SOLAR CHARGE SPECIFICATIONS:

The lamp's charge lasts for up to 1.75 hours after a day's exposure to full sun. The self-discharge rate for a fully charged battery is about 25% per week of not being used (power off).

Note: Turn the ON/OFF switch to OFF when charging.

REPLACING BATTERIES:

1. Open the battery door by sliding it backwards. Replace the old batteries with three new 1.2V 700mAH AA rechargeable batteries (nickel-cadmium).
2. Make sure the batteries are positioned correctly on the positive & negative terminals.
3. Slide the cover back until it snaps into place.



GRILL LAMP PLACEMENT:

1. Use the adjustable gooseneck to focus light on the cooking area.
2. Do not position the grill lamp directly above a fire or any cooking surface.
3. If your grill has a side burner, mount the lamp on the opposite side of the side burner.

USE AND CARE:

1. Store the lamp indoors when not in use.
2. The lamp can be cleaned by gently wiping with a damp towel. **DO NOT IMMERSE IN WATER.**
3. Remove batteries if the lamp will not be used for two weeks or more, since batteries could leak and damage the lamp.
4. Do not incinerate, compact or disassemble batteries.
5. Do not disassemble the solar panel and/or the lamp itself.
6. Recycle old batteries in a safe, environmental friendly manner. If recycling is unavailable in your area, dispose of old batteries in accordance with local regulations.
7. To turn on/off light, use the switch at the top of the unit.
8. Do not mix old and new batteries.
9. Do not use non-rechargeable batteries such as alkaline and standard (carbon-zinc) batteries.
10. Do not mix different type of batteries.
11. Do not overcharge the batteries.
