② Verify Minimum System Requirements

Make sure that you have the following:

- Broadband Internet connection.
- A Home Router with a free Ethernet (LAN) port.
- A computer connected to the Internet via the Home Router with the following characteristics:
 - Windows[®] 2000 or Windows[®] XP operating system*.
 - CD-ROM drive.
 - Microsoft[®] Internet Explorer 6.0 and up.
 - Screen resolution of at least 1024x768.
