## Recommended Installation Instructions

1. Read these instructions before proceeding to insure trouble-free performance of your high quality TIC Industries product. \*Note - whether your purchase was a Speaker or Lighting product these instructions apply, - please replace all instances of "unit", with Speaker or Lighting respectively.
2. Plan the location of the unit by making a simple sketch and estimating the length of cable required to access your low voltage transformer or amplifier. Check carefully for obstructions, water, trees, bushes, fences and particularly any area where house wiring or piping is present. Interfering in those areas could be dangerous.
3. Placing the unit.
  - a. Locate the unit and any speaker or lighting cable required.
  - b. Dig a four inch (4") trench alongside the cable run to each unit.
  - c. Check each end of the cable for adequate length and (Refer to your amplifier or low voltage transformer operating manual) connect to amplifier or low voltage transformer.
  - d. Should everything operate properly, close all trenches, sit back and enjoy!

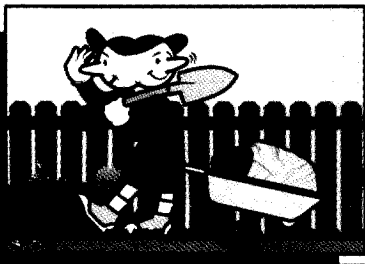
## Limited One-Year Warranty

If TIC product proves defective in materials or workmanship within one year of purchase, TIC will arrange for repair or replacement.

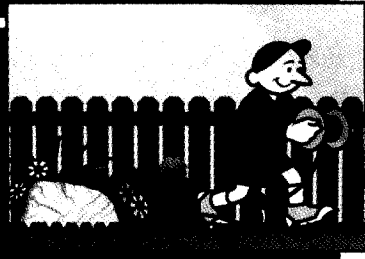
This warranty does not include damage to product resulting from negligence, accident, misuse or the light bulb of the Lighting unit.

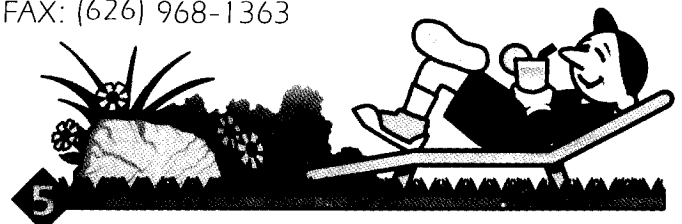
